Phase I- Renovation of an existing 17,117 sf historic wooden Coast Guard building into the NC Center for the Advancement of Teaching (NCCAT.) The interior consists of seminar space, 24 sleeping rooms, staff offices, and common living and break areas. A raised patio was constructed to connect the main building and the maintenance building. The exterior of the building is reminiscent of its original appearance with the use of Hardi-Shake siding. Several items of sustainable design were utilized



Phase II -Renovation of an existing 2,890 sf historic wooden Coast Guard maintenance building into the dining hall, commercial kitchen and 3-second story sleeping rooms. A geothermal HVAC design has been incorporated in both phases for energy efficiency and the water cisterns are to capture rainwater for reuse. A new fire sprinkler system has been provided throughout the building.
